 - (2) The Travel Fund may be used for expenses from projects to raise money for the Travel Fund.
 - (3) Funds not disbursed shall remain in the Travel Fund.

- (f) The Miss SDJD may be allowed an allowance of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day not to exceed six (6) days at the Annual Session of the Supreme Guardian Council.
