The next training for Job's Daughters Youth Protection Training is March 6, 2010 at the Best Western Ramkota in Sioux Falls. The Supreme Guardian Council has mandated that ALL adult volunteers eighteen years of age and older are required to meet and abide by the policy and program guidelines which may be found on the website www.iojd.org. 100% of the SD volunteers must be trained by May 31, 2010. All adult volunteers will be provided with a detailed training and must pass a screening process to help ensure the safety of our youth. The training will last approximately 6 hours and you must attend the entire session. The paperwork for the screening process will be handed out at the time of the training. The cost for the screening process is \$44.00 which is sent with the screening paperwork to Supreme. When you have been approved and receive your card you will be reimbursed \$26.00 by the SD GGC upon presentation of a copy of your card showing certification. Please attend this training as it is uncertain when there will be another one available, which may mean that you will have to travel out of state to be trained by the compliance date. This training should include active parents as well as council members.

Mark March 6, 2010 on your calendars NOW. The training will be held at the Best Western Ramkota, 3200 W. Maple St., Sioux Falls, SD starting at 8:30 AM. Lunch will be served at a cost of \$12.00 per person, payable at registration. If you need lodging there will be a block of rooms available at the Ramkota at a cost of \$89.99 plus tax per night **605-336-0650** (tell them you are with SD Job's Daughters). Please make your reservations ASAP as there are basketball tournaments that weekend also.
