Dear Bethel Guardians and South Dakota Job's Daughters,

Each year the Grand Guardian Council awards academic scholarships to some of our very deserving Job's Daughters, in South Dakota. Any member of Job's Daughter or Majority Member who will be attending a post – secondary school or trade school in the 2019-2020 academic year is eligible to apply. The scholarship will be awarded based on academics and merit, participation in Job's Daughters, community involvement, and work history. Please note that Job's Daughters and Majority Members who have previously received a scholarship from South Dakota Grand Guardian Council will not be considered.

To ensure that the scholarship award is as fair as possible, the Scholarship Committee is asking that the Bethel Guardian Councils assist the members with collecting the needed information. The scholarship application requires information about the Daughter's attendance and participation in Job's Daughters activities. Section B and C of the application are meant to be filled out by the Bethel Guardian Secretary and respective council members at the request of the applicant. Please assist applicants from your Bethel, to promptly completion these parts of the application. Both sections should be returned to the Daughter and submitted with the rest of the application packet.

Application packets must have all required information, including a transcript from the applicant's school, in order to be considered. **APPLICATIONS AND ADDITIONAL APPLICANT INFORMATION POSTMARKED AFTER MARCH 29TH WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.** Materials provided with the application will not be returned.

A copy of the scholarship application is enclosed with this letter. Please give each eligible daughter in your Bethel a copy of this letter and a copy of the application. Feel free to make as many copies as needed. The scholarship application is also available on the South Dakota Job's Daughters website.
